Analysis of Effective Honesty Relationships With Interprofessional Attitudes Through Outbound Activities: Literature Review

ABSTRACT

Education about interprofessional education is needed by every student, especially for students in the health sector. Collaborative skills can be done by using the outbound method. Doing outbound in nature, for example, is able to improve collaborative abilities in students without leaving their interprofessional nature as a student. Writing this article aims to analyze honesty as an interprofessional factor with outbound games in the form of ball games and trust walks. The writing of this article uses the literature review method with literature searches carried out through esources such as Google Scholar and ResearchGate. The articles obtained were analyzed using a simplified approach, namely by compiling the various articles obtained and simplifying each finding. The results of the literature review show that doing outbound in nature can improve students' collaborative abilities without leaving interprofessional traits. Through outbound activities, character building can also be carried out, one of which is honesty. Focusing on the application of honesty by playing ball games and trust walks in outbound activities can improve student honesty and collaborative skills.

INTRODUCTION

Education about interprofessional education is needed by every student, especially for students in the health sector (Damayanti & Bachtiar, 2020). Interprofessional has the notion that learning includes at least two or more health professionals who collaborate and are actively involved in achieving learning goals (Buchori et all., 2016; Putri et al., 2021; Ridar & Santoso, 2018; Marunung et all., 2023). It is very important that students understand roles, functions, and responsibilities to avoid negative views from society. According to (Mulyati & Trimarliana, 2017), interprofessional education is also beneficial for students in preparing them to the next level, such as practicing effective communication, increasing knowledge and understanding of professional practice, and being able to improve service quality in providing health services (Anwar & Rosa, 2016). According to WHO (2010), mentions the importance of applying this interprofessional education curriculum to students with the aim of improving treatment outcomes.

Forms of interprofessional education are building self-confidence, effective communication, training concentration, building leadership, being able to solve problems, teamwork, and practicing honesty (Petare & Landge, 2021; Sukawan et all., 2021). Honesty is one of the main aspects for students in building character (Saeful, 2021; Hadi & Muhid, 2022). Honesty is often associated with conscience and is a person's attitude in respecting others around him. Honesty is certainly very much needed in the world of work to provide information that is in accordance with the actual conditions to patients (Sirait et all., 2020). Not only that, by carrying out an honest attitude students can increase credibility and easily gain the trust of others to carry out a task. Conversely, if students already have bad credibility and do not apply the aspect of honesty, it will be difficult for others to believe them. This dishonest attitude makes other people's views negative and judges if the student is not trust worthy and responsible when carrying out a task. Professional relationships that are built on the basis of honesty will make others respect us and one of the paths to success (Lusiana, 2012).

Even though this interprofessional education has proven to be very effective in preparing health students in the future, not many health institutions have implemented it (Murdiany, 2021). Until now, there are still many who do not apply the aspect of honesty in carrying out their profession. We still encounter a culture of student dishonesty today, of course this will have a bad impact if it continues. As health students, of course we need to apply honesty as a form of professionalism in a profession, especially for students of public health workers. Based on this description, we want to train students' discipline, responsibility, and honest behavior in outbound games. Outbound is one of the modern learning methods that has the benefit of approaching each other by doing outdoor activities. This outbound will train the honesty of each team member and will be carried out in various ways, one of which is by playing a ball game and trust walk. It is hoped that by holding these games students can build trust and develop the ability to be honest with others.

MATERIALS AND METHODS

The method used in writing this article is literature review with a literature search carried out through-sources such as Google Scholar and ResearchGate. Literature review is a library research using the method of reading and reviewing various journals, books, and other manuscript publications related to research topics in order to produce writings related to a particular topic or issue (Triandini et all., 2019; Pratiwi et all., 2020; Setyowati & Kurniawan 2022). In the article search, 301 articles were obtained from 2017 to 2022 using the search phrase "outbound games"

Simplified approach is data analysis by compiling the various articles obtained and simplifying each finding. Articles are omitted if reportage and literature are grayed out.




Fig. 1. Flowchart Literature Review

According to (Dewi & Handayani, 2019) Playing games in nature can teach us to work together, improve discipline, creativity, care for the environment and society, responsibility, bring up a sense of leadership, and so on (Umar, 2011; Lawasi & Triatmanto, 2017). Through outbound activities, character building can also be carried out, one of which is honesty. Focusing on the application of honesty by playing ball games and trust walks in outbound activities carried out outdoors, is expected to improve student honesty and collaborative abilities.

CONCLUSIONS

Based on the results of research conducted there is a link between outbound and training students in interprofessional honesty. Meanwhile, inter-professional learning for students, including health students, is very effective in improving students' inter-professional collaborative skills. One of the methods that can be applied in increasing the collaboration of health students is using the interprofessional education method which is more effective with small group discussions or PBL. By involving scenarios and clinical presentations, IPE is effective so as to bring out common perceptions and IPE competencies among students. Outbound activities for students, especially health students, can be done by playing games. Through outbound activities by playing ball games and trust walks in outbound activities carried out outside the room can improve the honesty of students and the ability to collaborate.
